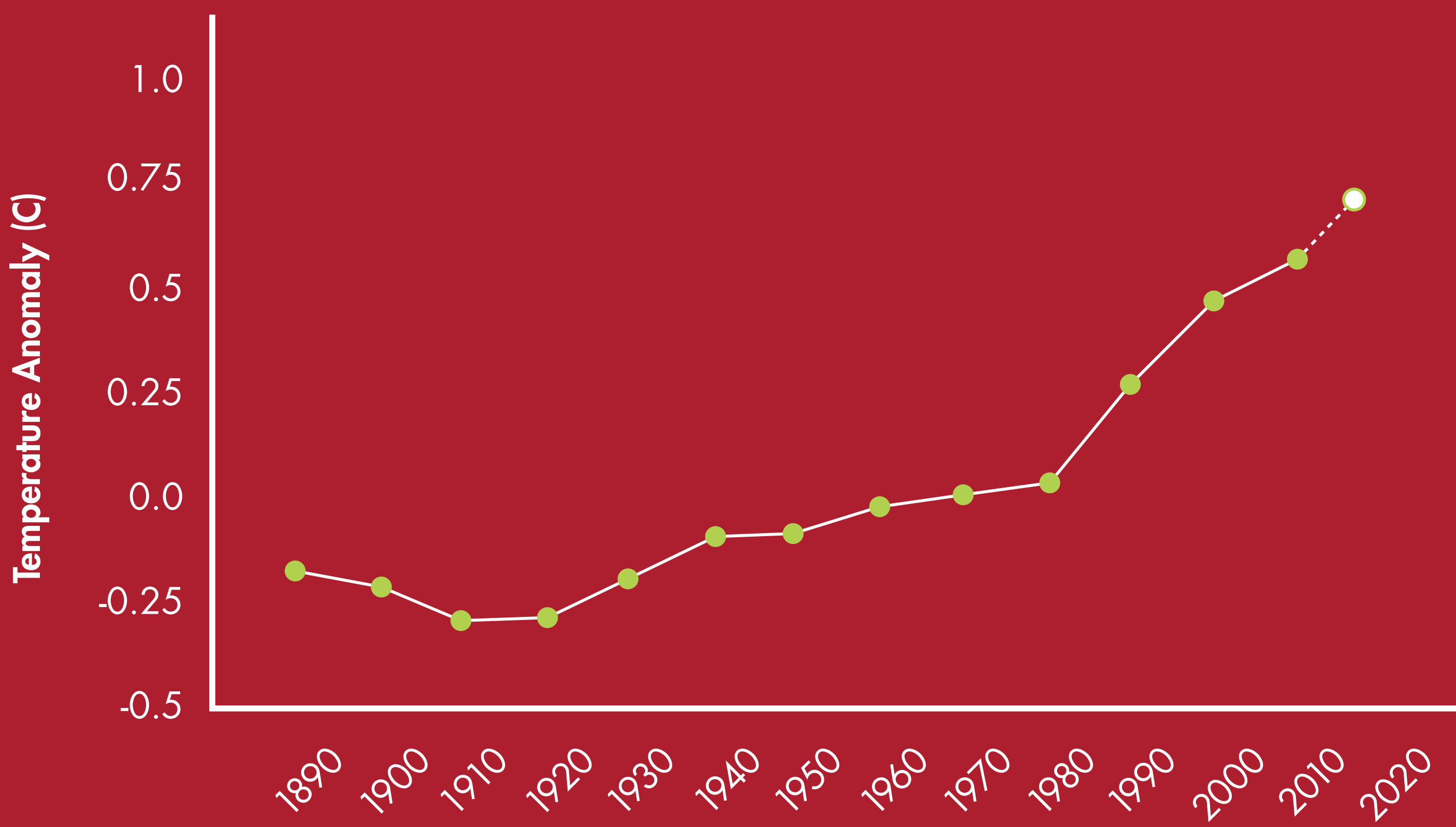


# GLOBAL TEMPERATURE RISE

## CHANGE IN SURFACE TEMPERATURES

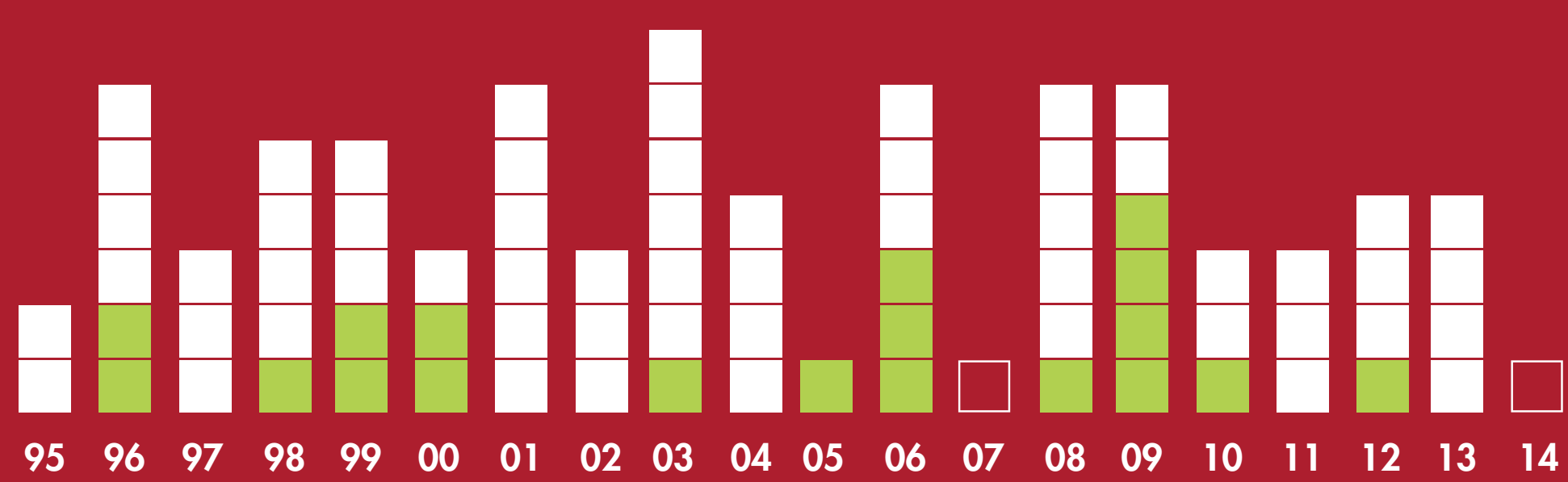


The graph illustrates the change in land-ocean temperature compared to the 1951–1980 average.

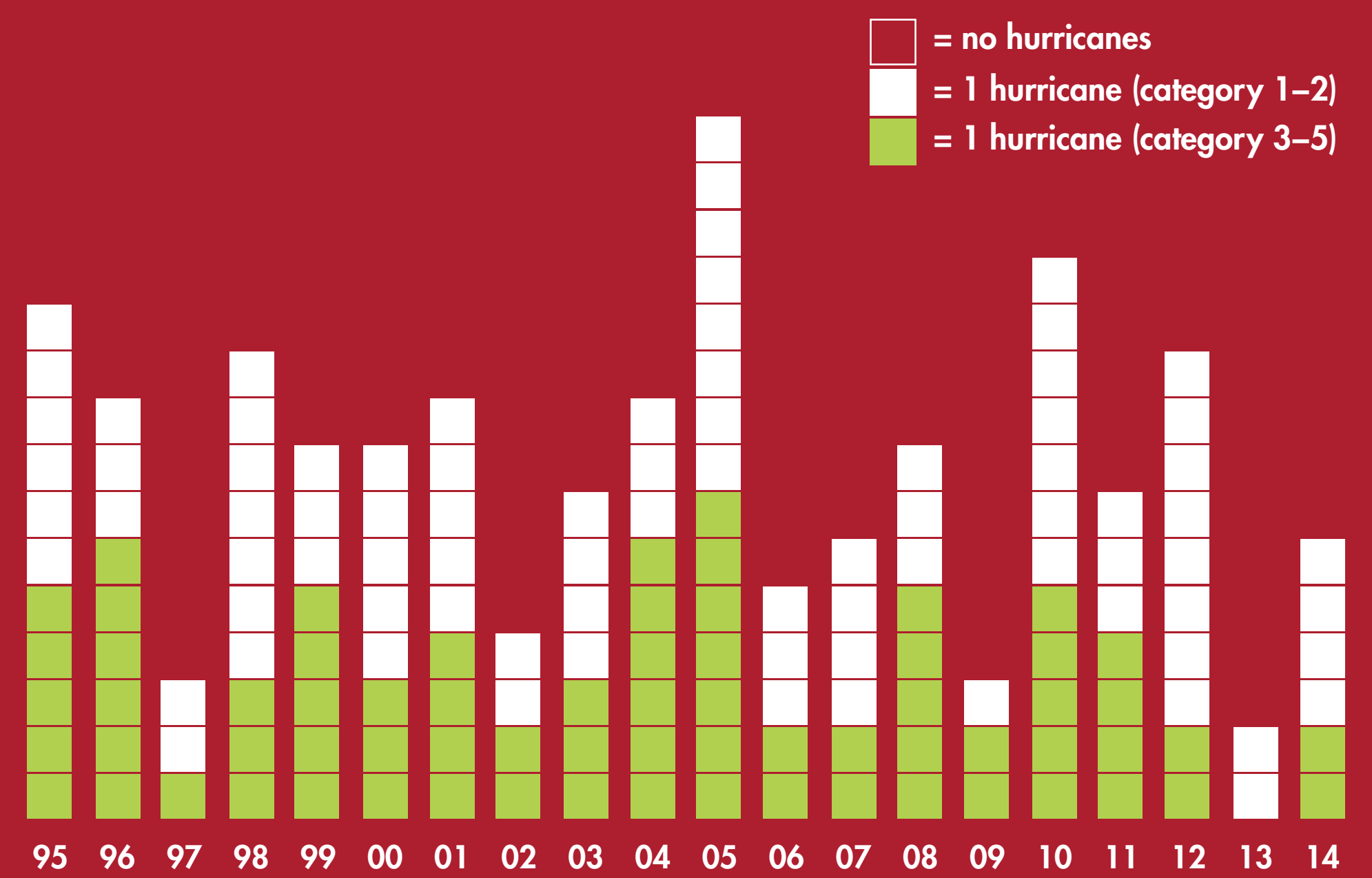
Ten of the warmest years in the history of record-keeping have occurred since 2000.
